

One of the farms main environmental and social initiatives has been the setting up of the pioneering and award winning community owned wind

Work began to investigate the potential for a wind farm in 1992 and after many roller coaster years of sweat and tears, the turbines were eventually commissioned in 2008. Westmill wind farm was the first wind farm in SE England the first wind farm in the UK to be initiated and realised by local people. It was set up as a co-operative so that local people could own and benefit from the project and has over 2000 members.

Westmill solar co-operative was formed in 2012 and was the first community group in the UK to develop and own a solar farm, and which for many years, was the largest cooperatively owned solar farm in the world.

Is a natural Burial ground established on the farm in 2004 and is run as a social enterprise. It covers approximately 3 acres and over the years it has won several awards. The 6 acre site had been previously growing willow biomass for the nearby coal fired power station but the power station didn't want the biomass (and is now decommissioned) and the usage of the that land changed.
